Using simple voice commands, you can ask Alexa to start a work order, request a repair, or check on work requests. Alexa understands a variety of commands, so try any one of these. Don't worry, you won't break her! If she doesn't understand your command, she will ask you for additional information.

Below are Some Examples of What to Say to Alexa

Try one of these Voice Commands to Start a Work Order Request

"Alexa, open Service Request"

"Alexa, open Request"

"Alexa, open Work Order"

"Alexa, create a Service Request"

"Alexa, create Work Order"

"Alexa, create Service Request"

"Alexa, start a Request"

Try one of these Voice Commands for Specific Repair Details

"Alexa, fix the kitchen sink"

"Alexa, my toilet is broken"

"Alexa, the lightbulb in the bedroom closet is not working"

"Alexa, the air conditioning in my apartment is broken"

"Alexa, fix the broken window in the living room"

Try one of these Voice Commands to Check on a Work Order Request

"Alexa, what are my Work Orders?"

"Alexa, show my Work Orders"

"Alexa, show Service Requests"

"Alexa, what are my Service Requests?"

"Alexa, show my Requests"

Work orders are also visible in the K4Community Plus App in the Requests folder, and on the Echo Show Display.
